4 BASIC SCREENING SCALES

Major Psychiatric Disorder; General Psychological Distress; Depression; Significant Antisocial Characteristics

21 BRIEF CONTENT SCALES

Close Relationship Difficulties; Low Self-Esteem; Depressive Feelings; Thought Disorder; Paranoid; Isolated/Alone/Alienated; Odd/Unusual Experiences; Stimulus-Seeking/Risk-Taking; Dysfunctional Childhood Home; Careless/Irresponsible/Impulsive; Undercontrol; Aggression/Anger; Childhood Conduct Disorder; Antisocial Characteristics; Fatigue/Low Energy; Health Problems; Anxious Feelings; Memory/Concentration Problems; Somatic Anxiety Symptoms; Likes to Perform; Verbal, Socially Outgoing

6 MISREPRESENTATION SCALES

Symptom Overendorsement; Erroneous Psychiatric Stereotype; Endorsement of Excessive Virtue; Endorsement of Superior Adjustment; Random Responding; Health Problem Overstatement
